Identify the decisionmaker for each role on LinkedIn. Message them thoughtfully after submitting your application within the first few days that the role is open.

2

Shape the skills section with words from each job description and interesting facts about you.

3

Avoid repetition, keep the action verbs that start each bullet varied.
